## **Safety and hygiene measures in the Open-air museum Roscheider Hof**

Keep sufficient distance from people who are not part of your home environment.

At the cash desk you will receive a numbered clothespin for access control, which you should wear recognizably on your clothing. When exiting the building, hang this clip back on the clothesline provided. This is the only way to get an overview of how many people are in the museum at any one time.

If possible, please make cashless payments.

Masks are compulsory in the main building and in the open-air museum buildings.

In the exhibition building, follow the one-way street signs to avoid encounter traffic. The only exceptions to this rule are wheelchair users and people with wheelchairs or prams.

There are strict access restrictions in adjoining rooms of the main building and in the museum buildings. These areas may be entered by a maximum of 4 persons or a household community at the same time. At the entrance to these areas there are clotheslines on which you place your clothespin, so that you can see how many people are already there and whether other visitors can enter. When you leave these areas, you take your clamp with you and thus clear the way for further visitors.

The lift may only be used by one person at a time and is mainly available for wheelchair users and people with walkers or prams.

Please avoid long queues in front of these areas.

Of course, you can move freely in all directions in the outdoor area.

Hand disinfection dispensers are available for you in the cash desk area and at the toilet facilities.

The toilet facilities are regularly cleaned and disinfected by our staff.

When visiting the restaurant, please observe the safety and hygiene measures applicable there.
